Eastbrook Sixth Form begins the process of post 18 options in September of Year 12, encouraging students to consider all avenues, enabling students to engage with "supercurricular" and careers activities.

Analysis of records in early September 2023 shows that:

- 45 students will begin undergraduate courses in 2024.
- 30 students have decided to take a gap year, of which 21 students have deferred entries for undergraduate courses in 2021.
- 1 student has entered a sponsored degree paid for by PwC.
- 1 student received a full sporting scholarship to study at Northern Kentucky University, USA.
- 1 student was offered a place at Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), USA.
