Provider Access Legislation (Baker Clause) Statement

At Eastbrook School, we utilise the Gatsby Benchmarks to guide the planning of our Careers and Enrichment programme. In our commitment to providing students with comprehensive information on the full spectrum of learning and training pathways available, we welcome requests from training, apprenticeship, and vocational education providers to engage with our students.

We proactively cultivate relationships with these partners throughout the academic year to ensure they have multiple opportunities to interact with students and their parents across Years 7-13. This engagement aims to provide insights into vocational, technical, and apprenticeship qualifications and pathways. We have established numerous partnerships with organisations such as NazLegacy, which offer a variety of employability and diversity days, showcasing career opportunities for all year groups.

Our staff involved in personal guidance and pastoral support are kept abreast of post-16 and post-18 pathways through a robust programme of Continuing Professional Development. Opportunities for providers to engage with students may include school assemblies, employer and provider engagement events, or one-on-one sessions with students and parents to support GCSE, post-16, or post-18 option choices.

The quality and impact of our Careers and Enrichment programme are monitored by the school's Senior Leadership and Governors. This includes oversight of access to and engagement with technical, vocational, and training providers.

Requests from providers are managed by the school's Careers Lead, Miss Awan. All requests will be evaluated based on factors such as staff availability to support the activity, potential conflicts with other scheduled activities, trips or visits, examination preparation, and the availability of suitable spaces to host the activity.
