Dear Parent/Carer,

Thank you for your support and to the students for their excellent efforts so far this year. Please be reminded of our expectations regarding behaviour and uniform. School uniform promotes a sense of community, belonging and pride.

To ensure that Eastbrook maintains the highest of standards, as of Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> June there will be a whole school focus on the following:

### Behaviour and Expectations

- Mobile phones are not permitted. They will be confiscated for 5 days if they are **seen or heard** past the reception gate.
- Students will be required to follow instructions first time, every time. Failure to do so will result in school sanctions in line with the school's behaviour policy.

### Uniform

Our uniform expectations are:

- Plain black polishable shoes.
- False nails and eye-lashes are not permitted in school.
- Hoodies are not permitted and will be confiscated if seen past the front gate.
- Studded earrings and a single nose stud are permitted.
- Rings and bracelets are not permitted for health and safety reasons.

Any student that arrives to school without the correct uniform will be placed in the Standards Room. Families will be contacted and if there is a valid reason the student will be given a Pastoral Pass until the issue is resolved. Students without a valid reason will be out of circulation until the issue is resolved.
